Rehearsal Attendance Policy

Theater is the ultimate team activity. It is so important that everyone is at their rehearsals. It is impossible to adequately rehearse a scene when some of the cast is missing.

- *The actors will <u>not</u> be scheduled to be at every rehearsal for the entire time.
- *Your child will need to be at all their scheduled rehearsals.
- * Please list ALL of conflicts on the conflict sheet. This MUST be brought to the Call Back Audition.
- *We do take the number of conflicts into account when casting a show.
- *Saturday rehearsals are mandatory. For already scheduled school obligations, you may be excused from ONE Saturday rehearsal, but it must be listed on your conflict sheet. Any other circumstances need to be approved by the director.
- *Beginning at least two weeks before opening night all rehearsals are mandatory for the full cast. This will include all tech/dress rehearsals.
- *An absence is considered unexcused if the child must miss rehearsal for any reason other than illness, family emergency or something that is NOT already listed on the conflict calendar.
- *After 1 unexcused absence, your child will be dismissed from the show.
- *You must contact the Stage Manager <u>prior</u> to rehearsal to be excused for illness or family emergency.

Please check <u>all schedules</u>, dance, sports, school conflicts, family activities, etc. when listing your conflicts.
