What Are You Doing? A Partner Pantomine, Improv, Imagination Game

Rules:

Your answer cannot be similar in any way to what you are <u>actually</u> doing. This is the most important rule and the point of the game!

No pausing. As soon as your partner asks what you are doing, you must answer. As soon as you answer, your partner must begin the new action.

You must keep doing your action until your partner begins the new action.

You are an instant expert in whatever action you are supposed to take on. HOWEVER you do it, it is correct! This is especially essential if you play the ABC Alliteration version

Make BIG choices.

No repeating.

Basic Game:

Partner 1 begins by pantomiming an action (pantomime eating an ice cream cone)

Partner 2 asks, "What are you Doing?"

Partner 1 answers by saying something they are NOT doing (pantomime playing basketball)

Partner 2 now begins to play basketball.

Partner 1 asks "What are you Doing?"...

Level Up:

Location Challenge: Set location that all actions might be taking place in, The Beach, a Theme Park, at School...etc. See how many rounds you can play by staying in that "location".

ABC Alliteration: Choose a letter of the alphabet. Your answer must be an alliteration of that letter:

- A- Adoring Alligators
- **B-** Balancing Bananas
- C- Cutting Carrots

ABC Alliteration on Steroids: Partner 1 starts with "A", Partner 2 must answer with "B"...
